ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

THE SCOTS PGC COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The scholarship was established to support students who wish to attend SCOTS PGC College. The scholarship is offered to a student whose financial circumstances are such that they would substantially benefit from this bursary.

The scholarship will provide financial support to help the student with resources and services relevant to improving their educational outcomes. It will include a payment of up to \$10,000 per annum when the student commences study at SCOTS PGC College.

The scholarship is to cover educational expenses such as:

- Tuition
- Boarding fees
- Uniforms and equipment
- Stationery and books
- Excursions and camps

The student must remain enrolled as a student of SCOTS PGC College for the duration of the scholarship. If a student leaves SCOTS PGC College before the end of the year in which he/she is enrolled, the scholarship will lapse. Any unspent monies at the end of the scholarship period must be refunded to The SCOTS PGC College Scholarship Fund.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY

- Intending to apply for enrolment at SCOTS PGC College (for Years 10, 11 & 12)
- Australian citizen or permanent resident
- Experiencing hardship
- Not currently enrolled at SCOTS PGC College

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Potential to do well at school and be able to demonstrate that the scholarship will make a significant contribution to reaching their educational ambitions.
- Commitment to study at SCOTS PGC College
- Evidence or testimony from the School Principal of your current school
- Evidence that the student is an active participant in school life and the community, in both curricular and extra-curricular activities will be considered favourably
- Agree to the terms and conditions of the scholarship, including providing feedback to The SCOTS PGC College Scholarship Fund Trustees' at the completion of each academic year during the scholarship period.

SELECTION PROCESS

A selection panel will review all scholarship applications and assess them against the selection criteria. The selection panel will include representatives of The SCOTS PGC College Foundation, a representative from SCOTS PGC College and independent experts. After considering all applications, the selection panel will recommend the selected applicants for the approval of The Trustees of The SCOTS PGC College Scholarship Fund.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome via email. If successful, the scholarship recipient's school principal will also receive notification directly.

APPLICATION FORM AND ATTACHMENTS

To apply for a Scholarship, students should complete the Application Form.

The application must include:

- Name of the scholarship the applicant is applying for
- Completion of the questionnaire
- Personal statement from the applicant explaining how you meet the selection criteria and how you would benefit from the scholarship
- Reference from your school principal explaining how you meet the selection criteria and how you would benefit from this scholarship
- Personal reference from a teacher or community member
- Full transcript of your most recent school report
