OUR FEES EXPLAINED

Fees are reviewed by the College Council on an annual basis, although Council reserves the right to amend at any time.

Technology Levy

Access to a College device, network infrastructure, software, printers and internet access and support.

General Purpose Levy

Covers such items as the College Student Planner, academic aptitude testing, bus fares for academic excursions and sport, some text books, online subscriptions, student accident insurance, and College sport.**

Boarding Activity Levy

Covers some weekend recreational activities for boarding students. Other optional activities will be organised whereby extra charges may be incurred based on participation.

* Subject Levies

Some subjects attract additional levies to cover consumables as per the list below. Certificate and Distance Education courses may also attract additional fees whereby families will be advised on an individual basis.

Subject levies related to the Industrial Technology Centre are charged per subject.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

A family discount is available if one or more siblings, normally residing in the same residence, attend the College at the same time. The discount is 10% for the second child, 25% for the third child and 50% for the fourth and subsequent children, provided that no child is in receipt of any other bursary or scholarship. This discount applies to the Tuition Fee only.

DUE DATES FOR 2020 FEE PAYMENTS

Other than in extraordinary circumstances and with the written consent of the Principal, no student will be allowed to commence a new Term whilst all or part of the previous Term's fees remain outstanding. A late fee of 1.5% per month is payable on outstanding balances where no arrangements have been made with the Principal or the Business Manager.

DONATIONS

An optional donation to support our Foundation's Building Fund, Library Fund or the P&F Committee is included with fee invoices. Donations are not compulsory and any support is greatly appreciated.

** Each year the State Government pays an amount to the College for every secondary school student (Years 7-12). This payment is used to maintain the College's Book Hire scheme and enables the College to keep tuition and book hire fees to a minimum.
