**SCRATCHINGS:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

**COMPLAINTS:** Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.

**MEMBERSHIP:** All competitors must be a member of the ACA as per the recent ACA ruling for affiliated camp drafts. ACA membership season is 1st April – 31st March 2022. No ACA casual memberships are available. *For this Draft*, all competitors must be current ACA financial members at the time of nomination and that membership number specified or your nomination will not be processed. No membership applications will be taken at the draft or on the day.

**STALLIONS:** As a Highschool draft, no stallions will be permitted to compete or attend this draft.

**COVID & ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS:** The SCOTS PGC College Campdraft will be conducted under COVID-19 government requirements. Do not enter Warwick Showgrounds if you are feeling unwell or exhibit any COVID symptoms. Physical distancing of 1.5m must be always adhered to at all times. Adherence to Covid Safety protocols including event check-in and

wearing of wristbands is a requirement of all persons attending the event. Sanitiser stations are located throughout the grounds. Hands should be washed or sanitised frequently. COVID 19 Management Plan is in place. All officials, volunteers, competitors and spectators must abide by it. QR codes will be in place. All campdraft competitors, visitors and volunteers MUST sign in upon entering the Warwick showgrounds, via **GATE 4** using the QR Code provided. This is preferred check-in system. Please stay up to date via our SCOTS PGC College Facebook page and Queensland Health guidelines.

**Please note:**

- a. This is an ACA Affiliated Event.
- b. No telephone, email or late nominations accepted.
- c. Unless otherwise advised competitors can regard their entries as having been accepted, but the Committee shall in no way be responsible for non-receipt of such entries.
- d. Nominations will be refunded in full if notified 7 days prior to draft.
- e. All riders to ride at their own risk.
- f. All horses will be run in order of the draw.
- g. Judges decision in all cases will be final.
- h. The decision of the committee on all matters pertaining to the competition shall be final, conclusive and binding on all nominations for the events.
- i. In addition, the Committee reserves unto itself the right at any time, without being liable for any loss or damage which may be sustained, to alter or postpone that date of events, or cancel the same or to change the venue of the events.
- j. All horses must have accompanying Horse Health Declaration.
- k. Numbers will be capped and a wait list will be in operation. First in basis.
- l. Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed
- m. Horse Status: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft)..
- n. The committee reserves the right to change the program without notice, refer to ACA RuleD.5.
- o. A Horse Health Declaration (HHD) is to be handed in on arrival and a rider wristband will be issued. If Gate 4 is unattended, check in via the QR Code and hand in your HHD at the Secretaries Desk. Copies of the HHD are available on Nominate. **No wristband NO ride.**
- p. All competitors MUST wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- q. Reminder that this is a school event and students MUST wear school campdraft uniform and saddle cloth.
- r. Dogs must be on lead.
- s. NO GLASS on site, only cans and plastic cups.
- t. Only the nominated rider for the horse is eligible to ride that horse over the weekend.
- u. All prize money should be divided using the following R9.

**Restrictions:**

- a. Riders limited to 2 first round runs (The Committee reserves the right to restrict nominations further in the event of excessive nominations and the availability of cattle)
- b. One horse / rider,
- c. Maximum of 2 horses / rider for Juvenile and Associate and one horse / rider for Junior Draft Competitors,
- d. MUST be attending highschool to compete.
- e. Must have representation of school when competing; ie saddle cloth, school campdraft uniform.
