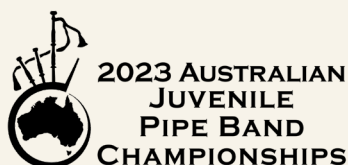

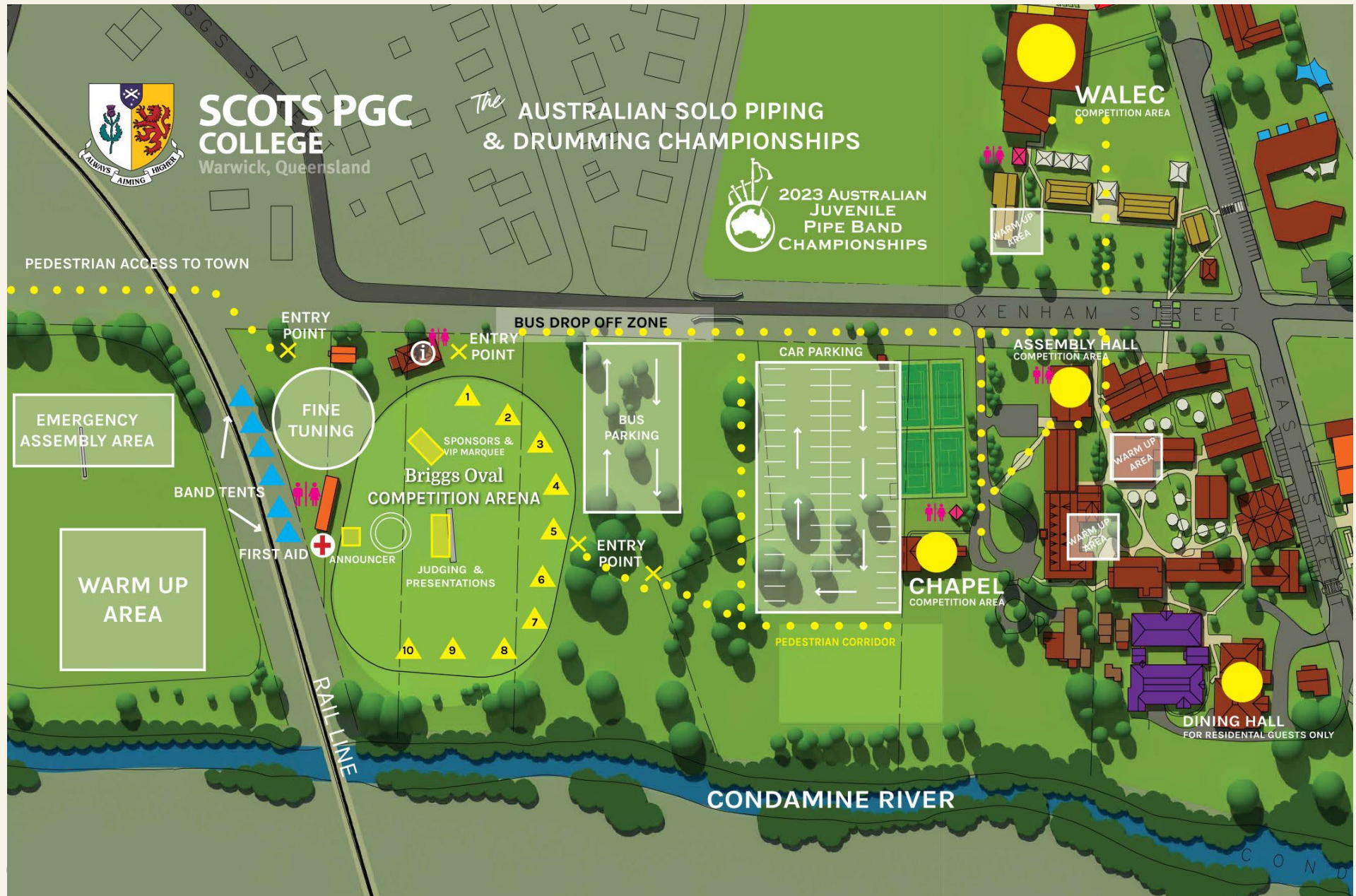
### Pipe Bands Australia

# Campus Map

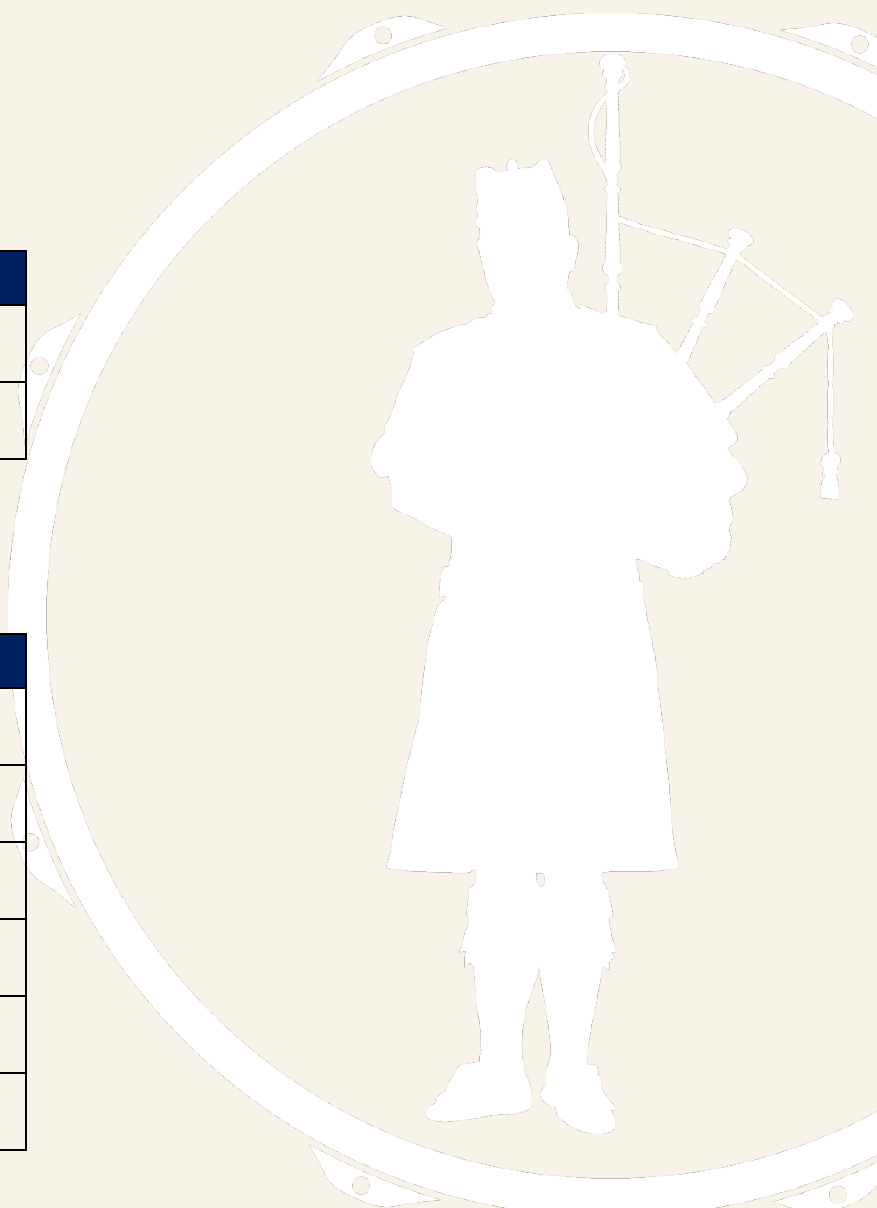
