Fees are effective from 1 January 2024

OUR FEES EXPLAINED

Fees are reviewed by the College Council on an annual basis, although Council reserves the right to amend at any time.

General Purpose Levy

Covers such items as the College Diary, academic aptitude testing, bus fares for academic excursions and sport, text books, online subscriptions, student accident insurance, and College sport.

Processing Fee*

A once only processing fee is charged for each application lodged.

Confirmation Fee*

A once only payment for each new family enrolling at the College. Where a family has more than one child enrolling at the College, the fee related to the eldest child is payable:

\$250 (Middle School | Years 6-8)

\$500 (Senior School | Years 9-12)

Uniforms

In the first year, families should allow between \$1000 - \$2000 to purchase all required uniform items.

Overseas Health Cover (OSHC): Students must have OSHC. Rates vary and are based on the length of visa approval. Visit the [OSHC Australia website](#) to compare policies and price

Subject Levies

An annual Subject Levy applies to Years 9 to 12 students in Art and Design and Technology. This is not reflected in the fee schedule and will only be charged if the student elects these subjects.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

A family discount is available if one or more siblings, normally residing in the same residence, attend the College at the same time. The discount is 10% for the second child, 25% for the third child and 50% for the fourth and subsequent children, provided that no child is in receipt of any other bursary or scholarship. This discount applies to the Tuition Fee only.

Other than in extraordinary circumstances and with the written consent of the Principal, no student will be allowed to commence a new Term whilst all or part of the previous Term's fees remain outstanding. A late fee of 1.5% per month is payable on outstanding balances where no arrangements have been made with the Principal or the Business Manager.
