- Evidence or testimony from the School Principal of your current school
- Evidence that the student is an active participant in school life and the community, in both curricular and extra-curricular activities will be considered favourably
- Agree to the terms and conditions of the scholarship, including providing feedback to The SCOTS PGC College Scholarship Fund Trustees' at the completion of each academic year during the scholarship period

SELECTION PROCESS

A selection panel will review all scholarship applications and assess them alongside the selection criteria. The selection panel will include representatives of The SCOTS PGC College Foundation, a representative from SCOTS PGC College and independent experts. After considering all applications, the selection panel will recommend the selected applicants for the approval of The Trustees of The SCOTS PGC College Scholarship Fund. Applicants will be notified of the outcome via email. If successful, the scholarship recipient's school principal will also receive notification directly.
